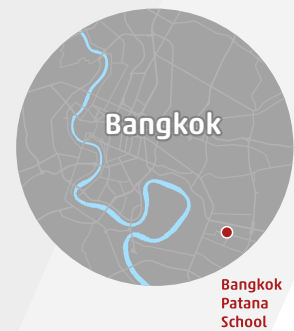

## What challenges were they facing?

Their learning community was using a myriad of virtual learning platforms. The diversity was making it increasingly difficult for the learner to manage all of the various portals, passwords from one subject to the next; they needed to consolidate their learning environment into one ecosystem.

## What has been the outcome?

After a two year study comparing and extensively trialling various virtual learning environments, Firefly was chosen as the primary electronic portal through which all learning interactions



take place. Its flexibility has allowed the school to integrate legacy platforms (for those that needed time to transition) and provides a consistent experience for the students, parents and teachers.

### **Why did they choose Firefly?**

The ability for the learner to curate their own learning content was the biggest single factor in influencing the decision, particularly when the process is intuitive and fluid; minimal fuss, maximum benefit.





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
