


Firefly for younger children




Complete flexibility to work across age groups

Infant schools, early years, primary schools, prep, pre-prep, and junior schools around the world use Firefly's online tool in their day-to-day teaching, learning and parental engagement.


Firefly lets teachers share their class' work with parents, at the whole class or individual level. This includes quick galleries, photos and videos, making it easy to choose what parents see. Parents can also comment on work or complete forms, such as for school trips.

Schools can tailor Firefly to the needs of different age groups and choose their theme. Each theme can be modified, for example using big visual icons for infant or pre-prep, and adding extra features like homework setting for junior or prep.



Storybook

We worked with Primary and Prep schools to ensure Storybook not only looks good, but is easy to use. It uses plenty of fun illustrations, bold colours and child-friendly fonts. Themes include Astro our space theme, Springtime our outdoors theme and Aqua our sea theme.



Melody

Melody is a friendly theme with a playful edge. Its styling is somewhat softer than our other themes, making it the ideal choice for schools wanting a bit of extra flexibility to customise.

Firefly saves teachers time and gives them easy tools to create high quality, visual resources for use in and out of the classroom. Teachers also have control over how they communicate with parents and involve them in their child's learning and achievements. Firefly is so simple to use that children can create their own e-portfolios and, when needed, teachers can use Firefly to set homework that gets parents involved.

We asked Christ Church C of E Primary School in Croydon about their experience with Firefly. Christ Church's vision is to work hand-in-hand with parents and carers to be a place where children become increasingly curious, effective, resilient and independent learners.

Case Study Christ Church Primary School

What was your situation before Firefly?

Before Firefly we were using a system from RM called Kaleidos, which was discontinued as part of their restructuring. Initially, we thought this was a huge blow, but actually gave us an opportunity and drive to see what else was out there. We came across Firefly and found that it was much easier to use, suited our needs and had the flexibility that we wanted.

Why did you choose Firefly?

We researched other options and learning platforms, and Firefly was part of that mix. Before getting in touch with Firefly, we emailed a number of schools that were using the platform. Their responses were very favourable with positive experiences of working with the tool and the Firefly team. So, sounded like a winner!

How did you roll out Firefly to teachers and students?


We found the roll out relatively simple, and staff and children were ready to adopt Firefly as there was already a culture of using a learning platform. We also spent an INSET day training staff and then launched with the children as soon as term started.

What improvements have you seen since Firefly was implemented?

From the outset, it was clear that the interface is much cleaner than our previous platform, it was really easy to use – for both teachers and students – and flexible enough to suit the needs of different teachers. It also meant we had a consistent approach to online teaching and learning across the school.

What are your future plans with Firefly?

We want to keep using Firefly the way we do!
